

European funds and Horizon 2020

The European Union (UE) provides funding opportunities for projects from many areas (research and innovation; environment; infrastructures; education, etc.). The areas involved are numerous and subject to competitive calls for proposals. Although the application process implies rules adapted to each call, there is a common corpus of rules – some of them unwritten- to be followed. *Lysios Public Affairs* offers to help you identify the relevant programmes for your project and prepare your response to a call for proposals.

The training will first go through all the major funding programmes, and then focus on Horizon 2020, which is the most important one, with nearly €80 billion of funding available between 2014-2020 and mostly dedicated to research, development and innovation projects all aiming at reinforcing Europe’s leadership in science and technologies. The other funding programmes are subject to similar rules and can also be studied specifically upon request.
